Thank you so much for all your faithful prayers. The Covid situation in Cambodia has improved. Travelers who come to Cambodia with a vaccination card require only one week quarantine at a hotel. I am so glad to hear this good news. God willing, I hope to go to Singapore for my health check and medical tests early next year. I appreciate your continued prayer, hopefully by that time the quarantine restriction will be lifted :)

Now gatherings are permitted with less than 50 people. Our church has met in person to worship for the first time since April this year. Thank God for His provision. A Christian NGO lets us use this spacious and clean place free of charge every Sunday. Our hearts were full of joy as we come to worship our faithful God together!



Prayer 1: Pray that God will grant our Khmer disciples to have His passion and love to reach out to their friends and neighbours and bring them to church!

We thank God that He has established the Hope for life church among the urban poor in Phnom Penh for over ten years already. We believe this is now the time for missionaries to guide them towards independence during the coming two years.

We and the Khmer leadership team will spend a couple of months to pray and wait as we seek God's guidance on what church model would be suitable for the urban poor setting?

Prayer 2: Pray for God's guidance for our small church plant as we work towards the process of independence.

Recently some of our church members have experienced many spiritual attacks. One leader who has the love and conviction to share the gospel with others regularly is very discouraged and sad because of the shortage of work and that he cannot pay his monthly mortgage. We have another potential leader who has a gift in teaching and who wanted to use her gift to serve God, but she has experienced many temptations that hinder her spending time with God.

Prayer 3: Pray that God will keep K & S strong in faith and that He will sustain them by His grace and power!

Thank you to you all for your prayers for my health. God has given me sufficient strength and stamina to serve the urban poor.

Prayer 4: Continue to pray for God's protection on my health from heavy fatigue as He helps me learn to pace myself in all I do :)
