How are you doing? I am very thankful to God that the Covid situation has improved and I am able to go to Singapore from June 4 to 13 to have my medical checkup and tests. This is good news indeed because all fully vaccinated travelers no longer need a COVID-19 test to enter Singapore!

Do you remember how I have shared with you that the most challenging task for us working among the urban poor is to disciple men to become mature followers of Jesus Christ? Thank you for your faithful prayers as God continues to work and bring changes in these men's lives!

Last week after worship, we went to the village to visit Chet and his wife Deun. Chet, a young man around 28 years old, came from a background of drug addiction and became a follower of Jesus when he was a youth. But, over the last two years, he stopped coming to church. He was satisfied that believing in Jesus in his heart was good enough. He was not interested in attending church or learning more about God through bible study. We have been praying for this lost sheep for these years! Thank you for working in this young adult's life. Throughout visitation, his wife Deun told us their marriage relationship was in trouble. They did not get along well. Because of the marriage crisis, God brought them back to Him. Chet asked our team leader Tobi, "can you have bible study with me every Tues evening?" **Praise the Lord that He answers prayer!** "...always pray and not give up" Lk 8:1.
